



**Prof Paul W. Miller, MD MB BCH BAO DMH MRCPsych FRSA**, is an author, Consultant Psychiatrist and founder of the Mirabilis Health Institute; an EMDR Europe Accredited Trainer and EMDR Institute (USA) facilitator. He is Visiting Professor in the Faculty of Life and Health Sciences at Ulster University. He has an active teaching and research portfolio and is actively engaged in collaborative research between Ulster University, University of Worcester, and several other institutes internationally. He is actively involved in international humanitarian work in association with OSMTH - a Non-Governmental Organisation in

Special Consultative Status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations, and with Trauma Aid Europe. His humanitarian work has supported projects on the Island of Ireland, as well as in Myanmar, Northern Iraq and he is currently focused upon the current conflict in Ukraine.

In 2020, he was awarded Fellowship of the Royal Society for the Encouragement of Arts, Manufactures and Commerce – this is an award granted to individuals that the Royal Society of Arts judges to have made outstanding achievements to social progress and development. A Founding Member of the Council of Scholars; an intellectual community of EMDR international thought-leaders and trauma experts, this group has been working to produce material that will advance the field, establish the parameters of EMDR efficacy, and identify areas for future research.

As a Consultant Psychiatrist and EMDR therapist, Prof Miller has over 25 years' experience working therapeutically with cases of PTSD and Complex PTSD in the general population, and in the first responder and veteran populations. He introduced EMDR therapy to Northern Ireland's NHS in the late 1990's and in 2011, founded Mirabilis Health, a private clinic specializing in trauma-focused approach to mental ill-health.
